# 1. Background

The Accounting Research and Development Foundation (Taiwan) (hereafter referred to as "the Foundation") will host the "2025 ESG Summit: Sustainable Disclosures Promoting Innovation" from August 26 to 28, 2025, in Nangang Exhibition Center, Hall 2. The event will feature engaging forums and performances, sharing new knowledge and facilitating expert exchanges to practically implement global sustainable development goals. Facing the challenges of global climate change, enterprises need not only internal transformation but also the strength to meet external challenges. In today's capital markets, the implementation of sustainability strategies and the effectiveness of actions have become key factors for investors to evaluate a company's performance in sustainability.

Under the supervision of the Financial Supervisory Commission, the Foundation held the "2022 ESG Summit: Environment, Social, Governance" in June 2022, inviting benchmark enterprises in sustainability development, social responsibility, and corporate governance. In November 2023, the "2023 ESG Summit" focused on "Sustainability Disclosure and International Alignment," featuring four professional seminars and one session on sustainability disclosure practices, advocating for ESG and enhancing the quality of sustainability disclosure in Taiwan.

Following this, in September 2024, the "2024 ESG Summit: Net Zero All-Round, Great Future for Sustainability" covered topics including International Financial Reporting Standards, auditing and assurance standards, valuation standards, XBRL taxonomy, as well as other issues, such as sustainability-related policies and regulations, sustainable finance, cyber security, internal controls, and circular economy.

## 2. Event Focus

### **Main Theme: Advancing Taiwan as Asia Asset Management Center**

1. Investing in Taiwan: Strengthening asset management; Promoting inclusive and sustainable integration; and Expanding investment in Taiwan

2. Sustainability Policies and Standards: Sustainable development policies; Standards for sustainability disclosures; and ESG talent cultivation.
3. Sustainable Digital Reporting: XBRL taxonomy standards; ESG InfoHub; and Carbon credit trading platform
4. Sustainability Disclosure and Reporting: Examples of sustainability disclosures; ESG evaluations; and Carbon footprint assessments and management.
5. Sustainable Finance: National green growth investments (insurance, securities, banking); and Linking investor relations.

The "2025 ESG Summit: Sustainability Disclosures Promoting Innovation" will be grandly held on the 7th floor of Hall 2 of the Nangang Exhibition Center (covering 15,000 square meters), that is an ideal venue for hosting international forums and seminars.

#### **4. About the Foundation**

The "Accounting Research and Development Foundation (Taiwan)" was formally established in 1984. The setting-up of the Foundation is aimed at enhancing Taiwan's accounting level, propelling continuous development of accounting, auditing and valuation standards, helping to build a healthy financial reporting system for industrial and commercial enterprises, and nurturing accounting-related professionals.

The Foundation operates at two locations, with its headquarters in Xizhi District, New Taipei City, and another office in Chengde, Taipei City. The Foundation has five professional committees: Taiwan Financial Reporting Standards Committee, Auditing and Assurance Standards Committee, Valuation Standards Committee, Sustainability Standards Committee, and XBRL Committee. As the only organization in Taiwan responsible for establishing professional standards for accounting, auditing, valuation, and sustainability, our goal for the sustainable development is to assist Taiwan enterprises in establishing sound financial reporting systems through the research and development of professional standards, thereby promoting the sustainable development of the capital market.

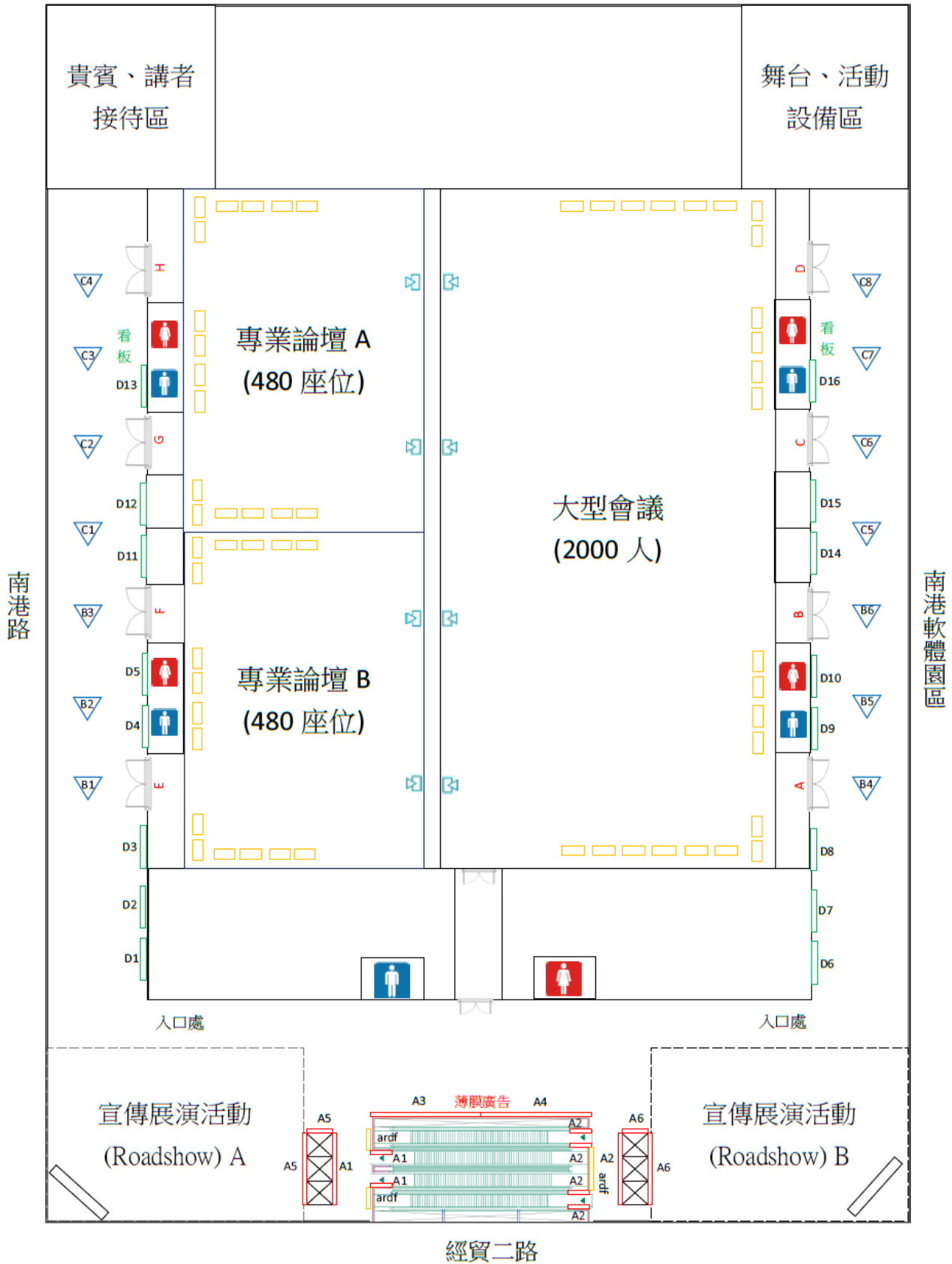

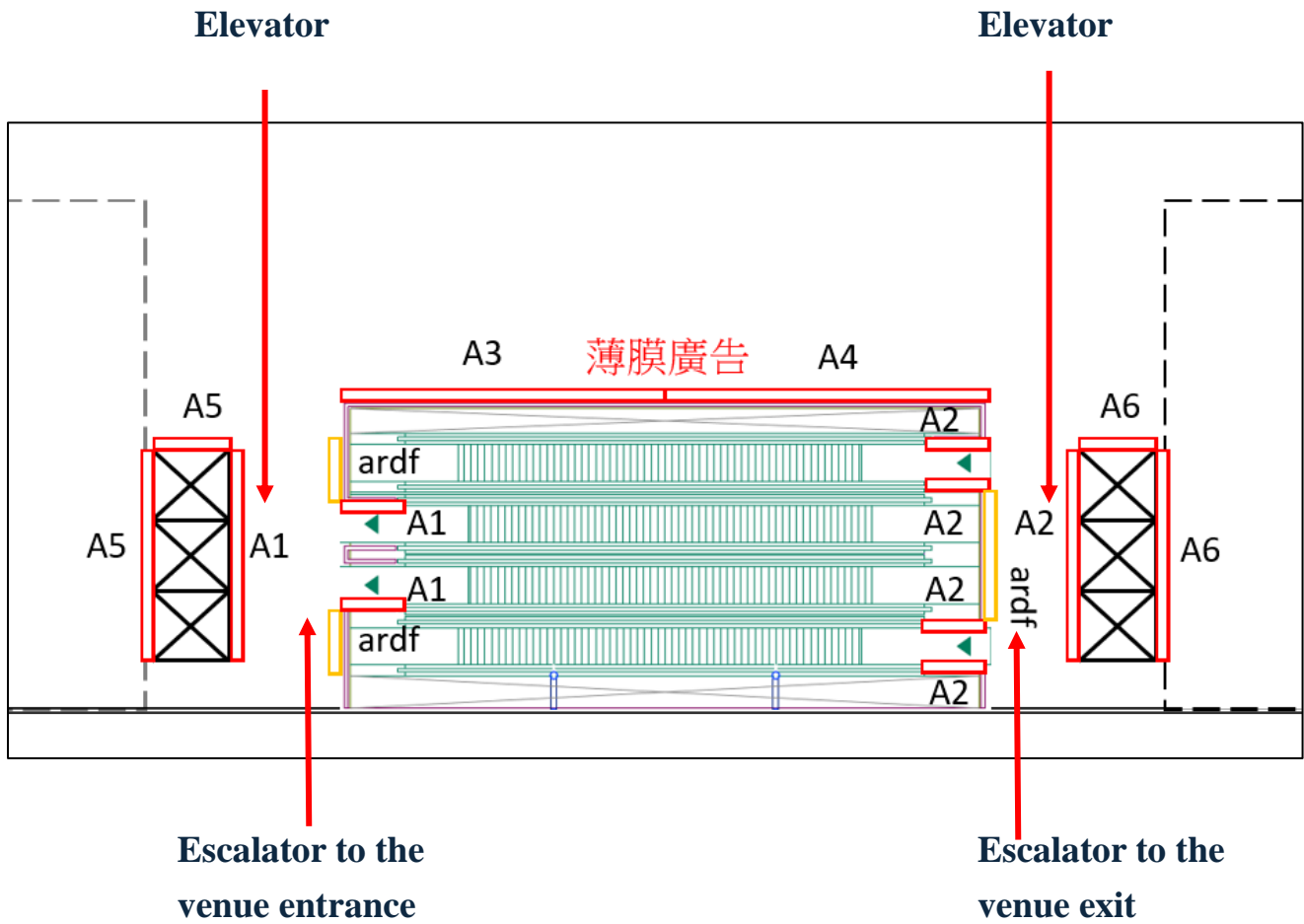
# 2025 ESG Summit Venue Layout
